

VETERINARY HEALTH ATTESTATION FOR BEEF

SAUSAGE (WORS)

Lesotho Permit Number

I, _____, the undersigned veterinarian/official authorized by the Director of Veterinary Service in South Africa attest to the following:

1. That the products or animals originate from an area free from quarantine restrictions for contagious or infectious disease such as Foot and Mouth disease, for the previous six months;
2. The animals must be born, raised and slaughtered in the country of origin;
3. The animals were slaughtered at an abattoirs with approved export slaughter facilities and the meat was inspected by authorized meat inspectors;
4. The beef sausages must be transported in containers, which are made in such a way as to prevent contamination of the sausages by disease causing agents;
5. The sausages must be loaded and sealed under the supervision of authorized officials and the seal number must be indicated on the International Veterinary certificate;

6. The exporter/importer has been informed that on arrival at the point of destination the nearest government veterinary officer must be informed so that he or she inspects the consignment before the products are disposed in anyway;
